

3 + 4 DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM

Earn your bachelor's degree in Health Science from Castleton University and your Doctor of Pharmacy from ACPHS in just seven years, and you'll be well prepared to change the future of human health.

HOW TO APPLY:

- Apply to the Health Science program at Castleton University.
- Submit a copy of your application to ACPHS. You will need to be accepted to each program individually based on each institution's admissions standards.
- You will formally apply to the Doctor of Pharmacy program at ACPHS by December 1st of your third year at Castleton University.

HOW IT WORKS:

- You will attend Castleton University for the first three years of the program, pursuing your bachelor's degree in Health Science.
- You will attend ACPHS for the final four years of the program, completing the requirements for your bachelor's degree and Doctor of Pharmacy degree.
- Students will matriculate at ACPHS once the following have occurred:
 - Completion of at least 90 credits at Castleton University with a GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - Completion of required pre-pharmacy courses at Castleton University
 - Successful completion of interview with ACPHS
 - Completion of writing assignment
 - Completion of the PCAT with a minimum score of 20
- You will receive your bachelor's degree from Castleton University once you have completed the first year of the Doctor of Pharmacy program at ACPHS.
