

# Teach Out Plan: Overview

No changes to current AP2s, P3s, P4s

## Current AP1s

- **Summer 2021:**
  - Skills IVA, Respiratory taught in 6 weeks (May 10- June 25, in person VT)
  - IPPEs (community, institutional) pushed back to begin July 5 – August 20
- **Fall 2021:** (remote or in person options):
  - Remove Skills IVA from schedule, move PAD 515 to fall
- **Spring/Summer 2022:**
  - Remove PAD 515 from calendar, Skills VA (spring semester or module A, in person NY)

# Teach Out Plan Proposal: Current AP1s (Class 2023)

(\*can be done in person in NY or remote)

- 2 changes from previous course schedule
  - PAD 515 was moved to fall
  - Pharmacy Skills VA (3 options)
    - Complete skills bootcamp spring 2021 and complete the rest of the course remote in spring 2022 with the NY cohort.
    - All students completed bootcamp and are eligible for this option\*
    - In person instruction in NY for the spring semester (course is the same as Skills VI).
    - Defer to module A, in person instruction in NY (summer AP3)



# Experiential Education

## Introductory Pharmacy Practice Experiences (IPPE)\*

**Overall, the IPPE selection and placement process will remain the same. The only minor change is a shift of the Team Based Care IPPE to later in the curriculum.**

- **Community and Institutional IPPEs:**
  - Begin June 28, 2021 and run through August 20, 2021
- **Team Based Care IPPE:**
  - Removed from Summer 2021; to be scheduled during 2021-2022 Academic Year

\*Only applicable to Class of 2023-A, as previous classes will have completed all IPPE requirements



# Experiential Education

## Advanced Pharmacy Practice Experiences (APPE)

**Overall, the APPE selection and placement process will remain the same for all class years. Students will have opportunities to complete rotations in Vermont, New York, or any other state at appropriate sites.**

- **Class of 2021 (Current P4s):**
  - On track to complete APPEs in May 2021
- **Class of 2022 (Current P3s/AP2s)**
  - Will receive APPE schedule in February/March 2021 and begin rotations in May 2021 (Current P3s)/July 2021 (Current AP2s)
- **Class of 2023 (Current AP1s)**
  - Will receive APPE schedule in February/March 2022 and begin rotations in July 2022

## Pharmacist In Training (PhIT) Portfolio\*

**Overall, the PhIT Portfolio requirements will remain the same.**
