

# 3 + 4 ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Our agreement with SUNY Plattsburgh gives you the opportunity to earn your bachelor's degree in Biology from SUNY Plattsburgh and your Doctor of Pharmacy from ACPHS in just seven years.

## HOW TO APPLY :

- Apply to the Biology program at SUNY Plattsburgh.
- Submit a copy of your application to ACPHS. You will need to be accepted to each program individually based on each institution's admissions standards.
- You will formally apply to the Doctor of Pharmacy program at ACPHS by December 1st of your third year at SUNY Plattsburgh.
- Your ACPHS application fees will be waived.

## HOW IT WORKS :

- You will attend SUNY Plattsburgh for the first three years of the program, pursuing your bachelor's degree in Biology.
- You will attend ACPHS for the final four years of the program, completing the requirements for your bachelor's degree and Doctor of Pharmacy degree.
- Students will matriculate at ACPHS once the following have occurred:
  - Completion of at least 90 credits at SUNY Plattsburgh with a GPA of 3.0 or higher
  - Completion of required pre-pharmacy courses at SUNY Plattsburgh
  - Successful completion of interview with ACPHS
  - Completion of the PCAT exam with a satisfactory score
- You will receive your bachelor's degree from SUNY Plattsburgh once you have completed the first year of the Doctor of Pharmacy program at ACPHS.

Students will need to complete the additional courses required by SUNY Plattsburgh for a baccalaureate degree including CHE371 or CHE401 & CHE 481, and PHY104 or PHY112.
