



Coronavirus Update #2 - Task Force & Updated Quarantine Information

To ACPHS Community,

In response to the coronavirus outbreak, we have created a Coronavirus Task Force to closely monitor this rapidly evolving situation. The task force is being led by Colleen McLaughlin, Chair of the Population Health Sciences Department and has representatives from the various college departments.

The Coronavirus Task Force will:

- Continue to actively monitor all guidance being provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), New York and Vermont state health departments, local health departments, and state education departments;
- Collaborate with ACPHS departments to develop readiness and response plans;
- Routinely communicate updates to the campus community.

We understand that many of you have questions since the information regarding the coronavirus is changing rapidly.

For the latest travel guidance, please go to the [CDC's travel guidance webpage](#). Both New York and Vermont have clarified that only those travelers returning from countries the CDC has issued a travel health notice for will need to be quarantined for 14 days. As of March 5, these countries are: China, Iran, South Korea, Italy and Japan. If necessary, we have quarantine options available on campus.
