Beyond vaccines, other COVID-19 treatment options, including monoclonal antibodies and new antivirals, are becoming available for patients with mild to moderate symptoms and for hospitalized patients. Some have HHS support and FDA approval or emergency use authorization as new COVID-19 therapeutics. Others are promoted on the internet with little or no scientific evidence of efficacy or safety.
