PowerPoint, Explain Everything, iPad Pro, Apple Pencil, Google Drive

TIPS

* Depending on your teaching goal, a learning module can be linear or non-linear set-up.

* The Table of Contents of a learning module can be expanded or collapsed if you would like to save some real-estate space of your window.

* **When to Use a Learning Module?**

- For units of content that require sequential experiences.

- For content best displayed as a "block" in a visual manner.

- For content with many levels in which the table of contents would be helpful for students to keep track of their location in the learning activity.

* Provide students with your recording script and PowerPoint slides for part of Universal Design and to serve as a helpful handout.

METHOD

1. [Create a learning module](#) in

BlackBoard.

2. Add contents to the module.

3. [Create a video](#) with Explain Everything.

4. [Export](#) the video to YouTube and [link your video](#) in your learning module.

5. Create formative assessment questions using advanced answer feedback options.

6. Link module components to questions using [adaptive release](#) techniques.
