
## First-time, Full-time Retention Rates First Year Cohorts 2014-2022



Full-time, first-time degree-seeking undergraduates who return and are enrolled the subsequent fall semester. Data collected from Title IV postsecondary institutions. Because retention rates are calculated from fall semester to fall semester at 1 year after entry, Fall 2023 is the most recent term for which retention rates can be calculated.
