

The Kappa Psi Endowment Fund (the “Scholarship Fund”) was established and historically used to award scholarships to students of the Beta Delta Chapter of Kappa Psi (the “Kappa Psi Chapter”) of Albany College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences (“ACPHS”) which was suspended in 2008 and is no longer active or maintaining a membership on the ACPHS campus. Under New York law, when the original purposes for which funds are donated become impossible to achieve, those purposes can be modified in a manner consistent with original intent by the New York State courts.

Accordingly, ACPHS has asked the New York State Supreme Court for the County of Albany to approve a modification of the purposes of the Scholarship Fund as follows:

*The Kappa Psi Endowment Fund shall be used to award annual scholarship(s) to outstanding student(s) who demonstrate a commitment to Kappa Psi’s mission of developing leaders with a passion for service to their community while creating lifelong professional connections. Students must be enrolled in the Doctor of Pharmacy program and demonstrate financial need, in accordance with ACPHS’s generally applicable scholarship policies and requirements for meeting academic eligibility.*

You may also make a formal filing in the legal proceeding entitled *Matter of the Application of Albany College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences For an Order Approving the Modification of Restrictions in a Gift Instrument Pursuant to Section 555 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law*, Albany County Index No. 908989-26.
